

Curling Club

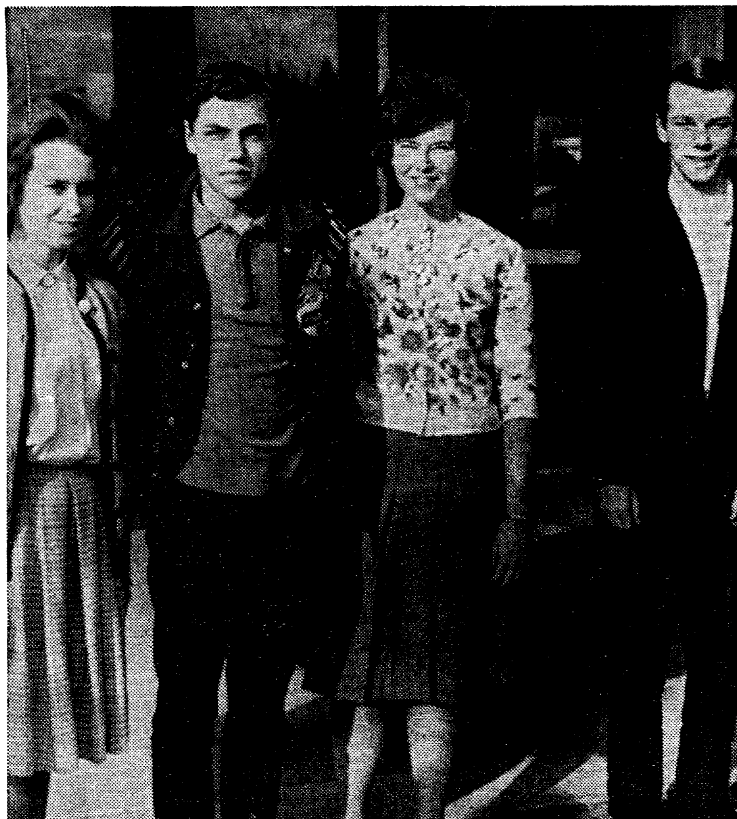
The curling club, with a membership of forty students enjoyed a very successful year. Four months of spirited competition among the ten teams were climaxed with a post-League Bonspiel.
