Many thanks to Chris Header, Dwayne Uyede, and Don Mitchinson for the assist.

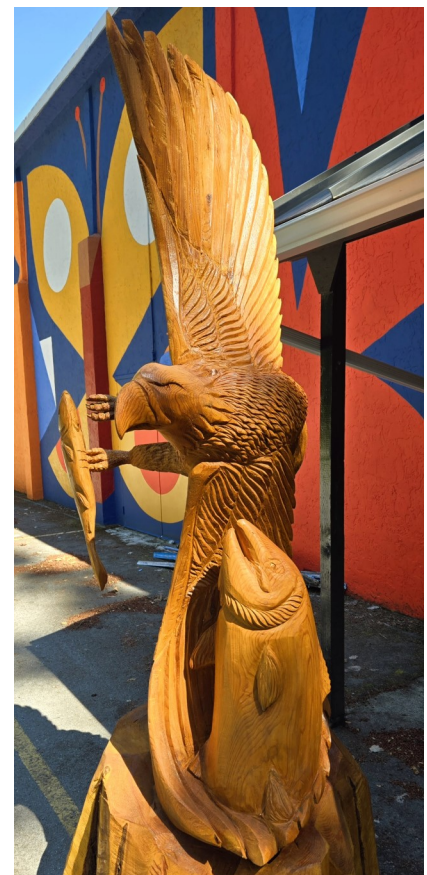


Outside you will see additional changes as the artist **Catnip** has created a new mural at the front right corner of the building to add a little colour out front.

Friday 16 August 2024



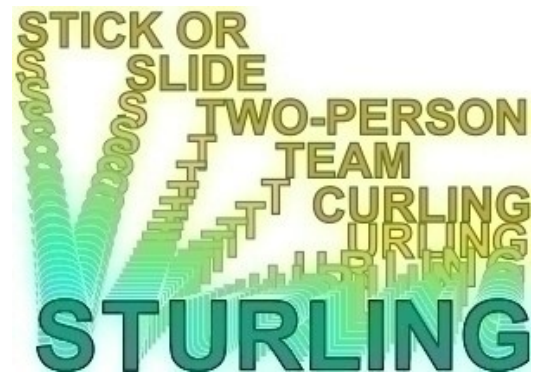

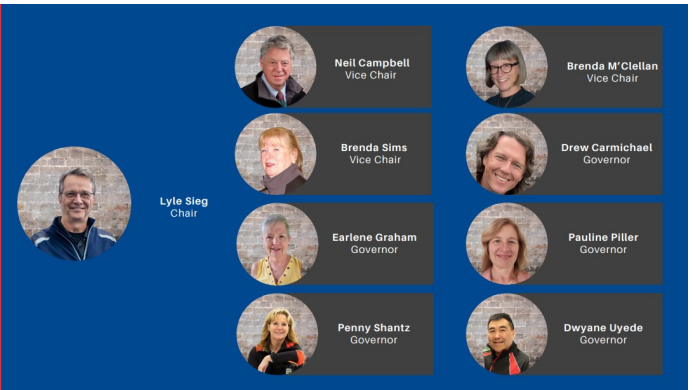
